In August, the association met with the current BH Ambassador Mrs Vesela Planinic and won her support along with that of the BH Ministry of Education, to run the group from this unique location.

The BH School Victoria began its work during the BH war, whereby a number of refugees gathered together with the support of several experienced teachers to set-up a regular Saturday School whereby school-age children would be educated, and their families could have a familiar and safe haven for the community to grow. Since then the group has steadily grown in numbers and parental support. From the outset, the group wanted to deliver a full curriculum, taught in the children's mother language.

"In August we met with Mrs Vesela Planinic, BH Ambassador in UK, and discussed the future of the school and the steps required to move into the new location. The new premises are big and luxurious and will hopefully motivate a new generation of BH citizens to prolong the mother language, its culture and to continue the BH project", said Mrs Semira Jakupovic.
